# Jill's Ferals Gamblers Choice

## 95. Jill's Ferals Gambler's Choice

Crossrails 18" 2' 2'3" 2'6" 2'9" 3' Height Sections to be judged together Each height will run co-currently with the jumpers

Each competitor has 45 seconds. During this time, they may jump all the obstacles they wish in any order and in any direction (Oxers to be made Swedish and 18" and crossrails will not have oxers). They must start at the starting point and their time ends when they hear the whistle, but they must go back through the finish line at the end. If the time is reached at the moment when the horse is already taking off (front hooves off the ground), this obstacle counts if it is correctly jumped. Any obstacle knocked down during a round will not be rebuilt; if it is jumped again, no points will be credited to the competitor. The same applies for knocking down an obstacle in disobedience. In the case of a disobedience without a knock-down, the competitor may jump that obstacle or continue to the next obstacle. The competitor who has obtained the highest number of points will be declared the winner. In the event of equality of points, the fastest time taken between the starting line and the finishing line will decide. 10 points will be awarded per jump.
